





Methodology

- Margin of Error: +/- 3.89%
- Election Day 2024-November 5, 2024
- Method of Interviewing:
 - Using exit polls made up of vote choice, demographic questions, and issue-based questions, students worked to survey local-Carlisle residents via an in-person anonymous poll

Univariate: Religious Attendance




Bivariate: Attendance and Age






Bivariate: Gender and Religious Attendance




Bivariate: Religious Attendance and Presidential Vote Choice
