### Collaborative Pennsylvania Exit Poll 2024 Cumberland County, PA Survey Questionnaire and Toplines

#### Methodology

**Number of Interviews:** 660 Voters in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. Questions 6 and 9 were survey experiments and had multiple versions of the question. Results for those questions are available upon request.

Martin of Error: +/- 3.9% at a 95% level of confidence.

Date: November 5, 2024

**Method of Interviewing:** All interviews were conducted in person, but were anonymous. Upon exiting the polling place, voters were asked if they wanted to participate. If voters agreed, they were given a clipboard with the survey questionnaire. Upon completion, surveys were placed in envelopes with precinct identifiers. The exit poll was conducted by students enrolled in Dickinson College Political Science classes, under the direction of Professor Sarah Niebler.
